## MUELLER MOBILE TRAINING VAN HEADS NORTH

For over 100 years, Mueller has provided product training to municipalities and contractors throughout the United States. We divide the country into four districts and each Summer and Fall we travel throughout a different district conducting between 25-50 training classes. We partner and work very closely with our distributors who sponsor these classes to provide training for the end user attendees.

This year for the first time ever, we have brought our training to Canada and are traveling coast to coast. We began the mobile training season in Langley, British Columbia on April 24th and will conclude in Windsor, Ontario on Sep 23rd. To date, we have conducted 12 classes in six Provinces for 707 attendees. There are 13 classes remaining. Once the 2019 season is complete we will have traveled and conducted training in nine provinces for approximately 1,500 attendees.
